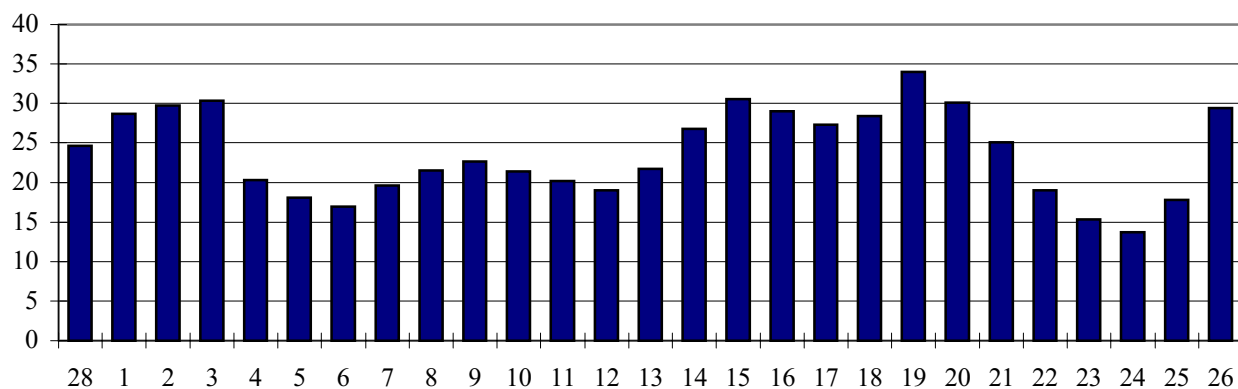

Lem-pedis alkoi **Perjantaina** 17.1 kun JPI lähti kello 9.30 Helsingistä ajelemaan Puntolla kohti Jyväskylää. YK:n luona söimme ja pakkasimme tavarat autoon. Punto oli hieman liian pieni kaikelle tavaralle joten jouduimme jättämään sukset pois, sillä asiat pantiin tärkeysjärjestykseen: nimittäin Ykän vaimo oli tehnyt meille pakkasrasioittain hyvää borssia, kaalipataa ja lihapataa punaviinissä, joten valinta oli helppo. Ruokaa riittikin sitten useaksi päiväksi. Kello 13 lähdimme ajelemaan Ykän pihasta kohti Tuomo Waaran kotia Pellon Lankojärvellä . Matkalla poikkesimme ihaillemaan suurta kauppakeskusta eli Zeppeliiniä ja poikkesimme jossakin hampurilaiselle. Kello 22 kaarsimme TW:n pihaan ja mittariin tuli juuri 900 km täyteen. Tuomon luona vaihdettiin kuulumisia yli puoleenyöhön asti.

Lauantai aamuna lähdimme aamupimeällä peruuttaen liikenteeseen. Lumisateen takia oli vähän vaikeuksia löytää kääntymispaikkaa joten pienen ojassa käynnin jälkeen löytyikin se oikea aukio. No, pieni aamujumppa Puntolla olikin paikallaan näin aamusta ☺.

Käynti Kolarin K- kaupassa ja viikon ostokset mukaan. Matkalla ihailimme lumisia maisemia, riekkoja, poroja ja yksi metsokin pongattiin.

Lemmenjoelle saavuimme klo 12.30 ja matkamittari ilmoitti kilometrejä kertyneen Hesasta 1234.

Tavarat sisään ja kuuntelulaitteita alettiin asettamaan paikoilleen. Kristiina innostui jäämään mökille jutustelemaan ja samalla kaminaa sytyttelemään. Vihdoinkin radiot toimivat ja jenkit kuuluivat joten asiat näyttivät toimivan, mutta kaikki preselektorit eivät toimineet. Uskomatonta epäonnea: tuomamme pressut eivät toimineet ja lemmenjoen varalaitteet olivat kanssa mykkiä !

Eipä muuta kuin nokosille (20-24) että jaksaa yön kuunnella.

Sunnuntaina heti puolenyön jälkeen nousimme ylös asemia kytistelemaan. Itselläni oli kovasti itärannikon asemat tähtäimessä joten panostin tähän yö kuunteluun koko reissun ajan, etenkin kun preselektorit pettivät. Kelejä oli ekana yönä, aamuna ja päivällä, pääosassa oli Suuret Järvet. Kelit olivat kuten lähes koko reissun ajan pääasiassa dominantti kelejä. Sunnuntai päivällä oli kivat japsi rähinät, joita olikin lähes joka iltapäivä, muutamaa hiljaisempaa päivää lukuun ottamatta. Päivän lämpötila oli -16, joka tuntuikin olevan yleisin lämpötila (?) reissun aikana. Nukkumaan 18 kieppeillä ja ylös 24. Illalla oli valitettavasti Auroraa taivaalla.

Maantaina noustiin siis heti päivän vaihduttua. Yöllä Laplata kuului jotenkin ja jenkit tulivat vasta 02 kieppeillä hetken. Brasseja mukavasti ja kelit poikki jenkkeihin. Aamulla jenkit taas ilmestyivät ja pakkaneenkin koveni 38 asteeseen. No vessa reissut nopeutuivat ja päivän antennitarkastus jäi väliin. Japsit tulivat vaisummin päivällä. Aloitimme myös joka iltaisen tradition eli TV:n katselun ennen nukkumaan menoa: JPI katsoi säätiedotuksen ja YK katsoi Pikku Kakkosen (Siljaa siis) ja ehkä uutiset ☺ Saunan ja nukkumisen jälkeen ibsutkin olivat vedottomia illalla.

Tiistai olikin sitten reissun huonoimpia päiviä. Yöllä oli vaisua ja vain lattareita kuului. Aamulla pari jenkkiä kuului hikisesti esim. Suurilta Järviltä ja ilahdutti jo tuskaantuneita kuuntelijoita, jotka ehdivät pohtia joko kelit tällä reissulla loppuivat. Pakkanen laski siedettäväksi joten antenni metsässä riitti hommia. Pari antennia oli vaarallisen alhaalla ja yksi maissa. Iltapäivän japsi kelit olivat heikot. Taas vakiounet 18-23.30 ja illalla ibsubreikeille.

Keskiviikkona jo yön jenkkikelit olivat paranemassa. Aamun ipsis ja jenkit mukavasti. Pakkanen nousi taas kovemmaksi eli 27 asteeseen joten antennimetsässä vietetty aika tuntui luissa asti. Japsit taas kivasti ja nukkumaan. Illalla ipsis kuului kivasti ja Auroraa taas taivaalla.

Torstai alkoi taas pikkutunneilla mukavilla häiriökeleillä jenkkeihin. Taajuudella 1650 tuli Eestin säätiedot ties mistä?! Aamulla kelit jatkuivat häiriöisinä ja asemia kuului hetken hyvin sieltä täältä. Hyvin mielenkiintoista kuunneltavaa. Mukavin nappaus reissun helmi minulle eli KAAY, myös muitakin mukavia asemia kuului. Päivä ja iltapäivä menikin antennimetsässä (lämpöä vain -16 astetta) ja laitteiden häiriöiden ihmettelyä tutkiessa.

Perjantai olikin peruskamaa joka suuntaan: jenkkejä jo (torstaista) 2330 alkaen, mutta kelit menivät poikki 0130. Yksi reissun mukavimmista asemista minulle kuului eli WVAA ennen kelien poikkeamista. Yöllä kävin ulkona nurkan takana ja takaisin tullessa tokaisin "Onpas siellä todella kova tuuli". Samalla sähköt pamahtivat poikki koko lähiseudulta. Eipä muuta kun herätys kuntoon eli radion volumenuppi kaakkoon ja nukkumaan. Yksi Sonyn MD lopetti joksikin aikaa toimintansa sähkökatkoksen seurauksena. Aamulla mukavat kelit itärannikolle mm. New York useilla taajuuksilla ja Floridasta kuului 1600 WKWF. Toinen sähkökatkos tuli myöhemmin jonka seurauksena sama Sonyn MD taas lopetti toimintansa tällä kertaa loppu reissun ajaksi. Tosin laite alkoi toimia kun oli päässyt Jyväskylään?! Alaskasta löytyi uusia asemia esim. 950 kello 1415 !

Lauantaina ipsis alkuyöstä mukavasti ja jenkkejä hetken ajan 00-, muttei edes kovin hyvin. Paras nappaus WSMN joka kuului hetken ajan mukavasti. Yö menikin poikkeuksellisesti unten mailla koska jenkit (tai muutkaan) eivät jaksaneet ponnistaa kylliksi esiin. Aamulla jenkit ilmestyvät vasta myöhään ja vain länsirannikolle. Kelit eivät innosta jatkamaan kuuntelua joten asemien hävittyä aloimme pakata. Punto lähti heti käyntiin (ilman mitään lohkolämmitintä) joten lähdimme tien päälle klo 11. Posotimme kohti etelää Ivalon kautta ja kun auton mankkaan vielä laitettiin klassista suomalaista viihdettä eli Koeeläintarhaa, niin pian (?) olimme Jyväskylässä.

Sunnuntai aamulla aamiaisen jälkeen tien päälle ja kotiudun Hesaan klo 13. Matkamittarissa oli parin kilsan tarkkuudella samat kilsat kun lähtiessä, joten matka Lemmenjoelle on yhtä pitkä/lyhyt ajoipa sitten Kolarin tai Ivalon kautta. - Muisteli JPI.

Loppuyhteenveto:

* JPI: oli tyytyväinen reissuun vaikka se olikin tuloksellisesti sieltä heikoimmasta päästä, mutta huomioon otettuna edellisen vuoden nolla kelit niin naama kääntyi näkkärille kun jenkkejäkin kuului. Rapoja on syntynyt aika kivasti eli yli 50 kpl joista n. 20 uutta jenkkiä, 10 jenkki urpoa ja 10 uutta ipsis. Myös uusia japsi rapoja syntyi jokunen, kaikkiaan aasiasta mukavat 10 rapoa. Parhaimpina nappauksina täytyy mainita mielenkiintoisten osavaltioiden edustajat eli 1390 WVAA,Vt / 1590 WSMN,Nh / 1090 KAAY,Ar. Ties mitä kivaa vielä löytyy minidisketeiltä. Lopuksi kiitokset Ykälle ja hänen vaimolleen, jolle vielä erikoiskiitokset hyvästä ruuasta. Emme olleet todellakaan nälkää nähneen näköisiä kun palasimme Lemmenjoelta...

Kiitokset myös koko Tuomon perheelle majoituksesta ja seurasta.

* YK: (vuoden LEM-tulokas) sai kasaan noin 50 jenkkirapoa (osa uusintoja ja ns helppoja) sekä parikymmentä muuta (japseja , ipsis , lattareita jne) .Suurin yllätys oli japsien kuuluminen voimalla . Diskettien höyläys on kovassa vauhdissa , ja pari UNIDia täytynee kuunteluttaa muilla . Kiitokset JPI:lle ja LEM Oy:lle mahdollisuudesta tähän reissuun !

BTW: Kun juttelimme Kristiinan kanssa ja katselimme hänen uutta TV:tä kysyin että oliko vanha tv hajonnut kun oli hankkinut uuden. Tähän Kristiina kertoi mökin DX laitteiden aiheuttaneen vikaa vanhaan TV:hen joten hän oli ostanut uuden. Kerroin ettei meidän laitteista tule mitään häiriöitä mutta hän oli varma että niistä se johtui...

Lokissa on poikkeuksellisesti mukana myös 1.sarakkeen asemat ja helppojakin asemia tilastointi mielessä (ja viime vuoden kelien kunniaksi, jolloin lähes 2 viikon reissun tuloksena oli 0 idattua jenkki asemaa /JPI).

A indeksi pyöri koko reissun ajan 10-20 välissä, painottuen eniten 15-20 väliin. Solar Flux kieppui vastaavasti 130 ja 140 välissä. Ainoa mainittava tapahtuma oli Minor Storm lähtöpäivänä. Eli ei siis mitään huippu muttei mitään huonoakaan keliä. Lem 174 taisi "rypeä" upeissa keleissä ?!

Matkaan päästiin vuorokauden verran jäljessä ennakkosuunnitelmiin nähden, mutta korvaukseksi pystyimme venyttämään pedistä vuorokaudella, sillä RS ja IPA ilmoittivat saapuvansa vasta keskiviikkona. Lemmenjoen vähälumisuus sekä neljän ensimmäisen vuorokauden lämpötila +3 - +5 astetta yllättivät. Sää olivat mainiot – kylmimmillään vain –11 astetta. Lähes päivittäin tarkistettiin antenneja tahtiin 2/mies. Lauantaina kelattiin pohjoislanka pois juuri ennen reissun parhaita Havaijikelejä. MKA tosin ennusti, että näin tulee tapahtumaan, viitaten Murphyn lakiin.

Kelit olivat häiriöiset: japseja ja jenkkejä kuului päivittäin, mutta yleensä vain Greyline-nousujen aikaan. Geoclock-ohjelmalla oli mukava seurata hämärävyöhykkeen etenemistä ja rytmittää kuuntelut sen mukaisesti. Iberialaisia tuli parina päivänä mallikkaasti – RNE1-aamubreikki 0645 alkoi vaan olla turhan myöhäinen valaistusolosuhteisiin nähden. 19. ja 22. päivän aussikelit kruunasivat reissun. Filippiinot ja thait olivat vaisuja. Raportteja syntyi ihan mukavasti laadunkin ollessa kohtalainen. –jsn-

Toinen kerta JSN:n kanssa Lemmenjoella ei tuonut suurta muutosta siihen johon olimme jo tottuneet. Keliä oli joka päivä johonkin kolkkaan Jenkkilää ja Aasiaa. Pari ilmiötä yllätti viikon aikana täysin. Yhtenä iltana oli sellaiset ilmakehähäiriöt, että vastaavia on ollut vain Livolla elo-syyskuun vaihteessa. Splittifilippiinon ja muiden ilta-aasialaisten kuuntelusta ei tullut tuona ainoana hyvänä iltana mitään em. häiriöiden vuoksi. Toinen oli skippikohdan auringonlaskun/nousun kelipiikki sekä itään, että

länteen päin. Se oli todella terävä ja saattoi kestää vain 10 minuuttia, näin ainakin japsien osalta. Itään päin oli suurimman osan ajasta ”verho” edessä ja ainoastaan japsit kuuluivat koko reissun ajan hyvin, eli tuon ”verhon” pohjoispuolelta. Tuo verho johtui CH:n aiheuttamasta aurinkotuulesta joka näköjään edesauttaa hyvien japsikeliä syntymistä. 22. päivänä tunnin kestänyt x-bandin aussikeli oli nautinnollinen, kun 1620:lla feidasi vähän aikaa kaksi aussia, oli sen session jälkeen olo vähän tyhjä ja huomasin pelkästään tuijottavani radiota.

Radioista en tässä nyt enempää porise, mutta Telefunken on paras myös Lapissa!

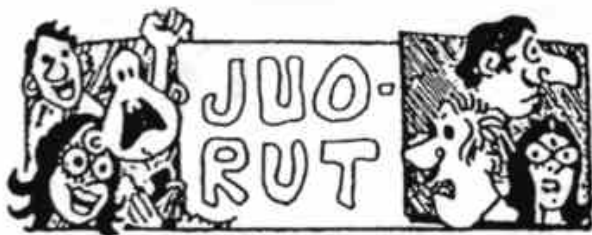

Here in Afghanistan, I have been able to help a DXer from Finland get a verification for reception of R Balkh in Mazar-i-Sharif. Mauno Ritola heard R Balkh on 1584 kHz on the 4th Oct, 2002 at 1547. He sent me an audio-clip by e-mail and asked if I could identify the stn. Quite fortuitously, a couple of weeks ago, the Manager of R Balkh happened to be in Kabul and visited my office. I played the clip and he immediately recognised the annr and the anthem played at close of txion. The manager, Mr. Abdul Rabe Jaheed, verified reception by writing a few words on a yellow Stick-It, which I have sent to Mauno. An unusual way to get a verie, but better than nothing! R Balkh bcs with 10 kW, so it was a very good catch. The Kabul FM wave-bands continue to fill with signals

from both Radio-TV AFG and international bcers on relay. BFBS now has two FM stns on the air (24 hrs in En by satellite from the UK) while the Turkish ISAF contingent also has a stn in the Turkish lang. French and German lang stns are also on-air, as is the BBC WS, the VOA, RFA and others. The first local community FM stns should be on-air by next month, thus ensuring that Afghan voices are more widely heard. Best wishes from a very cold and snowy Kabul. Iraq: U.S. Psyop Radio Shifts Focus

[Mar 4] The United States Central Command
quietly shifted its psychological operations
(psyop) broadcasts from the Iraqi military based
in Southern Iraq to the Iraqi public. The shift,
which went unreported by the mainstream
press, signals a major development in military
strategy that underscores the resolve of the
Bush administration in seeking Baghdad's
disarmament.

Information Radio, which is broadcast from the
EC-130E Commando Solo aircraft, now targets
the general public of Iraq. Approximately
360,000 newly redesigned leaflets advertising
the program and its broadcast schedule,
according to the Central Command, were
dropped over the cities of An Nasiriyah,
Rumaylah, and Al Basrah on March 1. The
cities are located south of Baghdad within the
southern "No Fly Zone" enforced by U.S. and
U.K. coalition jets.

"In times of crisis," one of the new leaflets

states, "Tune into 'Information Radio' for important news and information. Coalition Forces Support the Iraqi people in their desire to remove Saddam and his Regime. The Coalition wishes no harm to the innocent Iraqi civilians."

Says another, "The Coalition stands with the Iraqi people against Saddam. For your safety stay in your homes away from military targets. The Coalition does not target civilians. Listen to Information Radio for more information."

Information Radio broadcasts, which began in mid-December 2002, previously aired messages urging Iraqi soldiers to "make the decision" and support efforts to halt the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction. Its broadcasts, CRW has noted, were not intended for a civilian audience.

Listeners can monitor Information Radio on the following frequencies:

CYPRUS.

The 600 kW transmitter in Cyprus with Radio SAWA is supposed to have moved to 990 kHz (ex981) on 28 February, acc. to the current IBB online schedule. The beam of 140 degrees has remained the same (Bernd Trutenau, Lithuania, MWDX via DXLD) Viz.: 990 0000 2400 VOA MRN3 ARAB CYP A 140 (via gh, DXLD)

Thanks to a tip from Bernd Trutenau concerning the new R. Sawa schedule, I can now confirm that the station has indeed finally moved to 990 kHz. Audible here in Finland as I am writing this, with the usual format of a mix of Western & Arab pop music with short announcements. Because of more interference, reception on 990 kHz is however poorer than 981 kHz used to be (Mika Mäkeläinen, March 3, dxing.info via DXLD) DXLD

GEORGIA

Please note that R Hara (that is the correct spelling) is not a clandestine stn. It is a licensed, non-commercial Georgian bcer, based in T'bilisi, which is dealing in a comprehensive way with the relationships between Georgians and Abkhazians. ISRAEL

Israeli police raided the offshore Eretz Hazvi ship, anchored 6 miles off Tel Aviv, and closed down Arutz 7 broadcasts on *Christmas Eve* for one hour whilst police photographed transmitting equipment. The raid followed complaints about right wing propaganda being aired before a General Election, Israeli law prohibits this. The Minister of Communication apologised to Arutz 7 however a Judge subsequently issued an order restraining the station from election propaganda. (Press reports via Shaun Geraghty) Contact

KASHMIR

Radio Sadeye Kasmnir on 9890 being heard 0230-0310 in Urdu, 0310-0330 in another language, very strong in Hyderabad. Only .identifies as start of broadcast which is of songs and easy going talks. (Jose Jacob, dx_india via DXLD) Contact

KOREA NORTH [non]/KOREA SOUTH [non].

This afternoon in Maakeski listening post the AM band was rather dead, bringing only dreadful CNR-1 programme on 3-4 frequencies (990, 1377, 1539, 1593) so I switched to SW, which was a wise move. I logged some interesting Korean stations, including some clandestines I have very seldom heard. 4450 3.3. 1425- Voice Of National Salvation. "Kuguge sori". This North Korean clandestine transmitting to South happened to provide most entertaining programme. Nice Korean sentimental and pop music. 6348 3.3. 1245-

Echo Of Hope. "Shimang e meiari". Instrumental music and talk programmes from South Korea to North. 6400 3.3. 1235-Pyongyang BC, Kanggye. Refreshing military music and patriotic hymns for the glory of Great Follower Kim Jong-Il. 6600 3.3. 1250- Voice Of The People. The strongest Korean clandestine today, with obviously dry-as-hell talks hour after hour, that are supposed to enlighten the masses of North. (Jari Lehtinen, Lahti, Finland, March 3, dxing.info via DXLD)

KOREA SOUTH [and non].

A contribution of Andreas Niederdeppe to the German Radio-Kurier magazine (edition 5/2003) includes following monitoring observations from Seoul, done in last September: 657, 819, 999, 1053 and 1080 are subject of heavy jamming, also the shortwave // of the 1053 clandestine operation (but mind you, all other affected mediumwave channels carry regular services from Pyongyang). Also 6250 is jammed but not 2850 and 6400, possibly because 2850 and 6400 are out of range for radios in widespread use in South Korea. Andreas Niederdeppe also points out that the producers of the "Voice of the People" clandestine program (believed to be a KBS production if memory serves right) would have to be considered as criminals because broadcasting hymns praising Kim Il Sung and the armed forces of North Korea is a criminal offence. The 3912 frequency was probably selected because also North Korean stations broadcast on 75 metres, hence it appears to be likely that there are radios around in the North which can be tuned into this frequency. 6600 on the other hand was once used by Radio Pyongyang (Kai Ludwig, Germany, March 3, DX LISTENING DIGEST)

KUWAIT

Radio Kuwait English is 0500-0800 on 15110 and 1800-2100 on 11990. (Allen Dean, Lancashire,)Contact

1584 Radio Tikrit. A new clandestine station broadcasting to Iraq has been observed on 1584 kHz. The station broadcasts in Arabic and identifies as Radio, Tikrit, in reference to the town of Tikrit (located some 170 km north of Baghdad), where Iraqi president Saddam Hussein was born and where a large part of the ruling elite hails from. The power of the transmitter is not known, but it dominates the frequency even in parts of Europe in the evening, signing on at 1900. Radio Tikrit broadcasts popular Arabic music and brief announcements, and is obviously part of the US propaganda campaign against Iraq: A sample station identification is available on: www.dxing.info/audio/clandestine/1584_Tikrit.rm (DXing.info, February 6, 2003 via DXLD)

2058 - Sign off. "From Tikrit Radio, we wish you good night." Soft music heard briefly and the radio goes off the air. The radio was heard again on 1584 kHz at 1900 on 8 February. The opening announcement this time stated that the radio was broadcasting on 189 metres, corresponding to 1584 kHz (previous broadcasts had announced 1557 kHz). (BBC Monitoring research 7-8 Feb 2003, via DXLD)

They call themselves as R Tikrit and say often "...kullima-al-Iraq" = for all Iraq. When Twin Rivers Radio signs off at 1900, this starts on 1584 kHz, so probably via the Kuwaiti transmitter (Mauno Ritola, Finland, BC-DX Feb 7) MV Eko

R Tikrit and Twin Rivers R Tied to Opposition Group. By Nick Grace, CRW Washington with reporting by Andy Sennitt, R Netherlands Media Network and Robert Petraitis, CRW Lithuania. [Feb 24] R Tikrit and Twin Rivers R (Wadi al-Rafidayn), CRW and Radio Netherlands Media Network can exclusively report, are "sister" stns of the London-based exile group Iraqi National Accord's own progr, al-Mustaqbal (The Future). A representative of

the Accord, which encourages regime change through a coup d'etat, responded to an inquiry about the three radio stns with an invitation for listeners to send e-mail for all three progrs to the main Accord e-mail address.

<wifaq_ina@hotmail.com> The Accord and its stn, al-Mustaqbal, have long been known to receive funding and assistance from the U.S. Central Intelligence Agency. Multiple sources within the Iraqi opposition have independently confirmed that al-Mustaqbal bcs from a 50kW Harris tx located in Kuwait from a facility also used by the Voice of America. The tx bc R Hurriah (Freedom) progrs on behalf of the Iraqi National Congress between 1992 and 1997. Radio Tikrit's appearance in January 2003 on a freq once used by a CIA/Accord stn Voice of the Brave Armed Forces surprised most Iraq watchers since its initial bcs appeared to denigrate U.S. foreign policy. Subsequent progrs monitored by BBC Monitoring, however, blast the regime in Baghdad and attempt to win over the hearts and minds of Ba'ath Party bureaucrats and Republican Guard troops. Interestingly, a recurring segment of the progr called "Signs of the Zodiac" reads astrological forecasts. Although not uncommon in the Arab world R Netherlands Media Network's Andy Sennitt suspects the forecasts may, in fact, serve as surreptitious messages to foreign intelligence assets operating within Iraq. A source contacted today in Iraqi Kurdistan said "Here in northern Iraq people are completely mystified that anyone would name a stn R Tikrit. I have asked several Sunni Arabs what they think when they hear there is a new stn called R Tikrit and every one of them said 'CIA.'" The stns monitored schedules: Twin Rivers Radio 1600-1900 UTC 1566 kHz Radio Tikrit 1900-2100 1584 kHz al-Mustaqbal 2100-2400 1575.3 kHz Developing... (CRW Feb 24) 1584. A stn identifying itself as "Radio Tikrit", which was observed on 7 and 8 Feb to carry progrmes and nx echoing the Iraqi media and to refer to Saddam Husayn and the Iraqi regime in

respectful terms, was observed this week, on 15 and 19 Feb, to reverse its behaviour and to carry talks that were critical of the Iraqi regime and its leader. Unlike earlier in the month, when the "Open dialogue" progrme included items glorifying "Saddam Husayn's Iraq", the progrme this week included items highlighting poverty in Iraq. Newscasts were no longer copied from the nx progrmes of the Iraqi radio and television. The newscast on 19 Feb included an item highlighting the role of the UNs in vaccinating Iraqi children. Whilst the "Before it is too late" progrme on 7 Feb was critical of the US and its attempts to build alliances with Arab countries, on 15 and 19 Feb this progrme was sharply critical of Saddam Husayn's Republican Guards and the Public Security Dept respectively. Members of the Republican Guards were advised to leave their positions "before it is too late". Likewise, public security officers were advised by the progrme on 19 Feb to refuse the "orders of the tyrant" and "be brave before it is too late". Unlike Iraqi govt radios, it was not observed to s-on or off with the Iraqi National Anthem, nor did it play pro-Saddam songs. The stn was checked on 15 and 19 Feb from 1900-2100, sign-on to sign-off, on 1584 kHz. Reception continues to be poor because of co-channel interference and fading, which renders the radio unmonitorable for several mins at a time. (excerpt, BBC M, 19 Feb/released 22 Feb, via DXLD) There's nothing new within the item below; it's obviously based on the BBCM item recently published here, but it's interesting to see how BBC Nx is making this public. KYRGYSZTAN

1287 The 1st programme of Kyrgyz State Radio is broadcast in Bishkek on 1287 kHz (150 kW), and not on 1278 kHz as erroneously reported earlier. 1287 kHz was confirmed by recent logs in Finland. This transmitter used to carry Radio

Yunost in the early 1990s and was then listed on 1278 kHz in official Moscow lists, hence the confusion. Also provincial relays of Kyrgyz State Radio 1 are on the air, but further details are not known, the frequencies to look for are 1404/1431/1467 kHz. (Bernd Trutenau via MWDX 14.1.2003) MV Eko

4050 Hit Shortwave. Those weekdays I've had time to check this one at 1800 UT there always seems to be the religious (?) progr for some 25 mins. LEBANON

Voice of Free Lebanon concluded daily tests on 11515 1600--1700 22nd December, The Free Patriotic Movement said they would resume shortly for two hours a day. The US federal govt is pouring in an additional \$5.7 million to expand its Tinian-based radio stn, the IBB - International Bcing Bureau, to reach more countries in Asia Far East and the Pacific, it was learned yesterday. The U.S. Bcing Board of Governors awarded the \$5.7 million contract to Telesource CNMI Inc. on Feb 21.

Each shortwave antenna could reach places as far as 200 miles [sic!] from Tinian. Once the project is completed, Semikian said IBB, which operates the VoA and RFA, can reach China, INS, BGD, and other countries in Asia and the Pacific. Semikian expects the project to generate more jobs on Tinian in the next 12 months. Telesource currently operates the power system on Tinian. It built the \$32 million 20-megawatt power plant on the island under the build- operate- and-transfer scheme. The firm has been operating the Tinian power system for three years now and will turn it over to Commonwealth Utilities Corp. in 2020. IBB is Telesource's major client on Tinian.
