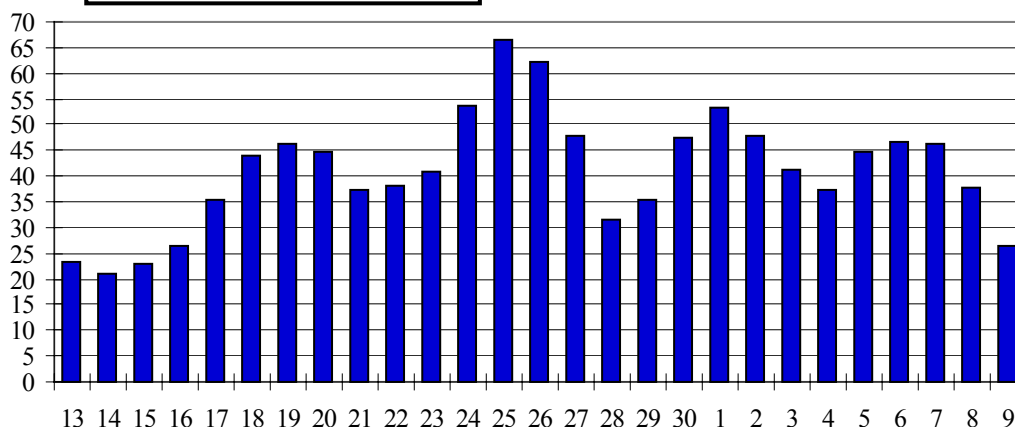

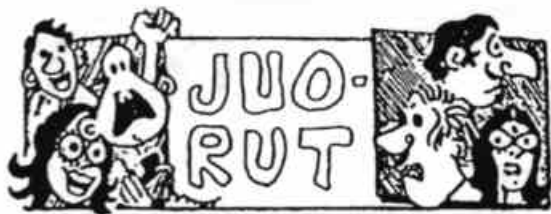

We urgently need you to pray for a very special need. Yesterday we tried to wire our Missionary in Liberia Money. The bank there refused the wire. This morning we received word that the fighting has reached the outskirts of Monrovia. There were 700 westerners there last week; today there are 50 left, as the US Consulate advised evacuation. Patty Heltsley, our missionary representative in Liberia, is very brave and wishes to stay on the ground, but all westerners are evacuating. As a nurse she has a great sense of duty and commitment, doesn't want to leave, but we feel it is in her safety's interest that she leave as well. So we need her out now! Please pray that she will drop everything and go.

She will be faced with two choices... To try to escape by car and risk encountering rebels and border problems. The second choice will be the airport, which will be the first target of the rebels. So please pray for the Holy Spirit's guidance in this decision. Pray for open doors for a ticket and safe passage.

Next, please pray for protection of all our employees in Liberia as they go through this difficult time. A suicide bomber once destroyed this station and the staff was lost... So pray for those that will be left on the ground, pray for God's divine protection. Please pray that the station and the Church will remain unharmed and that we will still be able to broadcast the Gospel.

Finally, we have a praise report to bring to you. Yesterday we were to Ship a 100,000 watt transmitter to Liberia from The Seychelles, with a replacement value of a quarter of a million dollars. Yesterday, it was to board a ship for transport to Liberia. We were refused because of one missing piece of paperwork. Today through God's divine hand we were able to arrange for this to be moved to UGANDA where we already have people and a station on the ground....What a God we serve! There will also be a television station there as well so we praise God. As you have read this email there are people dying in Liberia, so we plead for your prayers.

IRAQ

657 The Voice of Iraqi Liberation, previously reported on 1206 and 4025 kHz, has been observed on a new frequency of 657 kHz mediumwave.

The station was heard by the BBC Monitoring Service on April 18 at 0400-1100 UTC. The frequency of 657 kHz has formerly been used by the Kurdish and General services of the Republic of Iraq Radio. The transmitter site was unknown, but was believed to be located in northern Iraq. It is not clear whether the same transmitter is now being used by the Voice of Iraqi Liberation. The Voice of Iraqi Liberation was first discovered by DXing.info on March 6. It is believed to be run jointly by the Iraqi opposition, first using PUK-owned transmitters (1206 and 4025 kHz) in Sulaymaniyah.

720 A new radio station identifying as Radio Voice of the Mujahedin (Mujahideen) has been heard on the frequency of 720 kHz mediumwave. The station has aired commentaries opposing US troops in Iraq and has given airtime to the main Shi'ite opposition group, SCIRI, the Supreme Council for Islamic Revolution in Iraq. The station was first logged by Pentti Lintujärvi in Finland on April 11. The radio station, which broadcasts on 720 kHz - a frequency known to have been used by Iranian state radio - between 1400 and 1800 GMT also airs anti-Israel propaganda.

1170 A radio station identifying as The Voice of New Iraq and Iraq Media Network has begun broadcasting on the frequency of 1170 kHz mediumwave. The station was first mentioned by the Wall Street Journal on April 16 and first observed by the BBC Monitoring Service on April 17. According to the BBC Arabic Service, the station transmits at 21.00-01.00 Baghdad time (1700-2100 UTC). Conflicting reports give either Baghdad or Umm Qasr as the location of the transmitter - or there may also be two transmitters. According to the WSJ the station is using a 20-kW transmitter and was first on the air on April 15. According to the BBC, monitored by Tarek Zeidan, the station should be audible all over Iraq.

The Nikkei company is the publisher of a financial newspaper, the Japanese equivalent of the Wall Street Journal. NSB will celebrate its 50th anniversary next year and its slogan, "Radio Tanpa", will be changed on that occasion.

The majority of reports have come in for tests on 41 metres: 7300, 7370, 7385 and 7737 KHZ. We have discontinued the use of 7300, 7385 and 7737 KHZ. We do still test on 7370 KHZ. Presently, we are testing on 9983 KHZ, and on 15185 KHZ, simultaneously. These frequencies carry the regular programming of ZP20 Radio América, which also broadcasts on 1480 KHZ. We have, as well, an experimental station on the Medium Waves, in Villeta: Radio Villeta, which operates on 1590 KHZ.
