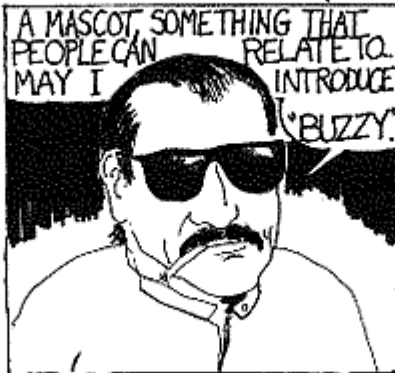
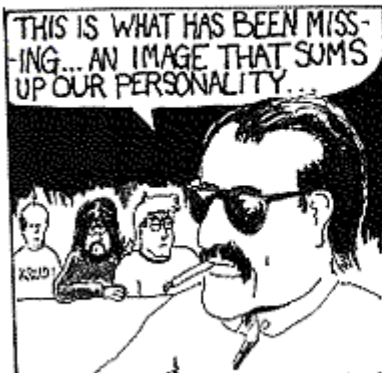

At the end of March Belgian national radio company VRT turned off three of its four AM transmitters<http://wikiatic.com/wikisearch/search?q=VRT%20turned%20off%20three%20of%20its%20four%20AM%20transmitters>. Those were the transmitter of Radio 2 in Wavre (**540 kHz**, 150 kW), Radio 2 in Kuurne (**1188 kHz**, 5 kW) and Radio Flanders International in Wolvertem (**1512 kHz**, 600 kW). The transmitter in Wolvertem (927 kHz, 300 kW) remains in operation. By eliminating the transmitters VRT saves on maintenance and energy. (Radiovisie)Dxing in the Finnish way

GERMANY

Burg 1575 goes dark: And so it happened, the Burg transmitter is off, maybe for good. Dominating station on 1575 here in eastern Germany is now Genova, with Spain underneath. Last night Burg was still on with DRM, so the transmissions must have been stopped manually during the working hours.

Burg 1575 goes dark: At 0100 the scene had changed completely: Now Radio Farda was booming in, loud and clear. In detail the only interference where some raging wobble jammers (the ones already heard here when hurricane Kyrill had knocked off the main power supply at Burg), and level-wise the signal had the appearance of a transmitter inside Europe, with the rather pronounced fading being the only indication that this was not the case. Good enough reception to say that the audio processing is quite aggressive.

And this time I indeed waited until a drop gave a clear ID, no matter how unambiguous the Persian pop music may be. Just amazing, I can't remember a signal even remotely as strong from a mediumwave transmitter more than 4000 kilometres away.

Frankfurt-based Hessischer Rundfunk 594 kHz will no longer broadcast on mediumwave as of 2010.

All programming produced for mediumwave distribution will be discontinued, including the broadcasts for immigrants in Spanish and Greek.

This measure is part of a today released program to save 64 million Euros until 2012. Director Helmut Reitze says that the primary goal of this program is to ensure the existence of Hessischer Rundfunk as an independent body.

Exact deadline not specified, but could be 31 Dec 2009. The remarks by Helmut Reitze are not exaggerated, gossip had it recently that a worst case scenario for Hessischer Rundfunk would be to become the Frankfurt outpost of Südwestrundfunk. The program line-up on 594 contains also live coverage of sports and events that matter, as well as broadcasts in other foreign languages,

originating from Cologne and Berlin (i.e. just relayed, thus not mentioned in the press release).

This doomed mediumwave program is also carried on Astra 1H, as "hr-info +", besides the regular hr-info (as on FM). But this is not a real name, just a satellite channel designator.

Polish Radio management have decided not to renew the contract with TP EmiTel to broadcast on longwave 198 kHz from Warsaw/Raszyn. This decision has been made because of the financial difficulties of Polish Radio. The contract will expire from the beginning of August. This means Radio Parliament will disappear, as will the longwave transmissions of the Polish Radio External Service, which currently uses 198 kHz on days when it is not broadcasting sessions of parliament.

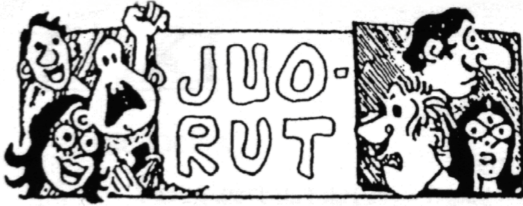
